NOTE TO APPLICANTS:

The licensing fee is \$25 for an anhydrous ammonia bulk storage facility (farm/private) exceeding 6,000 gallons (22,712,47 liters) of storage capacity and \$100 for each retail and storage site (\$100 for combined retail and storage). The license is valid indefinitely, but may not be transferred. For a facility to sell anhydrous at retail in North Dakota, a fertilizer distributor license is required in addition to an anhydrous ammonia license.

No permanent anhydrous ammonia storage facility may be constructed after June 30, 1985, without a license issued by the Commissioner of Agriculture. Before constructing a new facility, initial approval must be obtained from the board of county commissioners in the county which the facility is to be constructed.
