
#### Inform Decision Makers

 Mission: "useful and practical information on subjects relating to agriculture, natural resources, food and nutrition, family education, rural development, energy, and 4-H youth development"






1. The transformational education model encourages strong relationships with stakeholders and documented impacts

3. Continue current allocation of resources to program areas as mandated by federal, state and local levels

Name change: NDSU Extension


Motto: Extending Knowledge. Changing Lives.

2. Revise financial partnership with counties







#### **NDCCA Motion**

"endorse the revised NDSU Extension Base Funding Policy for calendar year 2019, with the expectation that NDSU Extension, SBARE and Counties will work to restore state funding so that a longer-term funding model that reduces the property tax burden can be achieved. The motion was seconded and passed on a voice vote."





3. Increase engagement/input with stakeholders and ensure they are aware of opportunities for input





4. Establish a state-level Citizen Advisory Council and recommend each county have an advisory council
