Court Facility Improvement Grant Application

The State of North Dakota awards grants to counties for improvements or maintenance to court facilities. Eligible projects must be a necessary improvement to court facilities or essential to remodel or maintain existing facilities.

Counties receiving grant awards are reimbursed up to 75% of total project costs, and are responsible for the remaining 25% of expenses. Applications are due by December 31, 2019.

The Clerk of Courts Office has requested Cass County submit a grant application for expenses related to updating and remodeling four office doors to utilize card swipe technology. The doors currently have locks that require users to depress a series of buttons in a particular sequence to release the lock.

The quoted price for the equipment and instillation is \$6,048.58. Buildings & Grounds indicates additional electrical work, estimated at \$1,200 will also be required to complete the job.

Total estimated cost, including associated expenses, is \$7,300. 75% of that amount is \$5,475. Cass County requests consideration of this Application for Court Facility Improvement Grant Funds in the amount of \$5,475.

The basic ements are that the improvement or maintenance project must be a <u>necessary improvement</u> to <u>facilities</u> or <u>essential</u> to remodel or maintain existing <u>court facilities</u> . Full description of the improvement or maintenance project for which grant funds are requested (attach additional sheets if necessary - <u>include vendor estimates</u>): The Clerk's Office has requested Cass County submit a grant application for expenses related to updating the door locking mechanisms on four office doors to utilize card swipe technology. The doors currently have locks that require users to depress a series of buttons in a particular order to release the lock. The quoted project cost for the equipment and instillation is \$6,048.58. Cass County Buildings & Grounds indicates additional electrical work, estimated at \$1,200, is also required to complete this project.		
	Note: Because the county has a federal statutory obligation to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act, projects for ADA-related improvement or maintenance will not be considered.		
3.	Estimated total cost, including material, labor, and associated expenses, of the project: \$7,300 . Itemized cost (material, labor, other expenses): Total cost assumes associated expenses will be limited to \$51.42 in addition to the product and electrical expenses described above.		
1.	County local funding contribution (must be <u>at least</u> 25% of the project's total cost): \$1,825 . (Note: In-kind contributions will not be considered for purposes of satisfying the 25% contribution requirement. Depending on the nature of the project, the Advisory Committee may require local funding in an amount greater than 25% of the project's total cost).


