WHEREAS, all available resources remain committed to protecting life and property;

WHEREAS, the impact of rural fires will threaten the health, well-being, and safety of citizens in Cass County;

WHEREAS, the cost of response in the inordinate equipment wear may be far in excess of available Cass County resources;


