Good morning Taylor,

I spoke with with our local police officer Joseph Koerber out in Kindred and he gave me your name and contact details!

We are having a tailgate event on Friday, September 23 in Kindred between the parade and the football game. Due to construction on the elementary school, we will not be able to use the parking lot just North of the football field like we did last year. We will be moving the event across the street (Co Rd 15) from the field to the West by RDO and the Memorial Building and have our vendors set up there for music, food, and tailgate activities for the kids.

One concern we have is the busy road - County Road 15. We are asking permission to block off that road from 5 p.m. (when the parade starts) until 9 p.m. (after half time of the football game) to allow our community members and children to safely be able to go back and forth between the game, activities and food vendors. The section we are requesting we could block off would be right at the end of Linden Street and then to the North to the entrance into the Elementary parking lot. I've attached a map for you as well and we talked to RDO as their business would be affected and they said it's just fine at that time of the evening as they are accessible by parking on the street or through their South entrance.

We thought we'd reach out early, as we are starting to line up food trucks now and just want to ask and see if this is something we could do.
