

NOTICE FOR WEED CUTTING

In accordance with the North Dakota Century Code, it is the duty of landowners or operators with land adjoining regularly traveled county and township highways to mow weeds and grasses on the said road right of way. The cutting shall be performed by the owner or operator between August 30, 2022 and October 1, 2022. The minimum cut width shall be 12 feet from the edge of the roadway. The maximum height of the remaining stubble shall be four inches. If landowners fail to cut the weeds and grasses along the county and township roads, the county board of commissioners or the board of township supervisors may cause the weeds and grasses to be cut and add the associated expenses to the tax bill levied against the land for the ensuing year.
