Allowable Costs

Recipients should consider requesting the following when developing budgets, in furtherance of award activities. The financial resources provided are required, by law, to support activities intended to address prevention and response to COVID-19:

- 1. Personnel costs related to COVID-19 testing and mitigation efforts according to CDC guidance for confinement facilities
- 2. Laboratory COVID-19 testing supplies
- 3. Collection supplies, test kits, and other necessary supplies for diagnostic or screening COVID-19 testing
- 4. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) (e.g., masks, gloves, gowns) for those collecting samples and/or conducting testing

Non-allowable Costs

- 1. Clinical care such as medication and patient treatment
- 2. Purchasing or leasing vehicles
- 3. Construction
- 4. Social services not related to isolation and quarantine and/or case investigation and contact tracing efforts
- 5. Incentives

Any other costs not listed above will need prior discussion and approval.
