# REGULAR MEETING OF CASS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS NOVEMBER 20, 2023

#### 1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Chairman Chad M. Peterson called the meeting to order at 3:31 PM with all members present as follows: Tony Grindberg, Duane Breitling, Jim Kapitan, Mary Scherling, and Chad M. Peterson.

#### 2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Taylor Kaushagen led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### 3. MINUTES APPROVED

MOTION, passed

Mrs. Scherling moved and Mr. Breitling seconded that the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as written. Motion carried.

# 4. AGENDA, Order approved

MOTION, passed

Mr. Kapitan moved and Mrs. Scherling seconded to approve the order of the agenda. Motion carried.

#### 5. CONSENT AGENDA APPROVED

MOTION, passed

Mr. Grindberg moved and Mr. Breitling seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows: On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

- a. Receive monthly financial statement from the Finance Office for month ended October 31, 2023.
- b. Approve raffle and paddlewheel permit for Central Cass Dollars for Scholars to be held on December 2, 2023 at Lone Oak Farm Event Center in Ayr, North Dakota; approve calendar raffle permit for Embden Community Club to be held from January 1, 2024 to January 31, 2024 at the Embden Community Club in Embden, North Dakota; and approve raffle permit for Cass County 4-H to be held on April 23, 2024 at the Red River Valley Fairgrounds in West Fargo, North Dakota.
- c. Approve purchase of 2024 Case 821G Wheel Loader with Auto Grease System and trade in a 2014 Case 821F for \$190,903.22 from Titan Machinery; retroactively approve purchase of repair to safety padding in Jail booking cell #11 with Marathon Engineering Corporation in the amount of \$5,771.
- d. Accept the 2024 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) through the North Dakota Attorney General's Office on behalf of Red River Children's Advocacy in the amount of \$23,920; and accept Back the Blue grant award in the amount of \$249,806.00 to be utilized for retention and recruitment for the Sheriff's Office.
- e. Authorize the Chairman and Finance Director to sign the quit claim deeds for tax-forfeited properties redeemed by the former owners.
- f. Accept the findings and recommendations of the Cass County Planning Commission and staff and approve the final plat on the condition that access to the existing property is modified to comply with the Cass County Highway Access Ordinance, as the proposal meets the goals and objectives of the Cass County Comprehensive Plan, the Cass County Highway Access Plan, the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, and all other applicable regulations.
- g. Contract approval-
  - -Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc—ArcGIS Enterprise Agreement;
  - -Burleigh County Sheriff's Department—Inmate housing agreement for 2024.

#### 6. PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Peterson asked for public comment and hearing none, moved on to the regular agenda items.

### 7. ABATEMENT, Action tabled for Jon and Dawn Sierman

County Director of Equalization, Paul Fracassi was present to discuss an abatement application submitted by Jon and Dawn Sierman for a property located at 1201 Elm Street North in Fargo. The applicant has requested a reduction in value from \$285,900 to \$125,900 for 2022 and from \$257,200 to \$97,000 for 2021. This application was considered by the Commission on October 16, 2023 and was tabled to allow the applicant to provide additional information.

Mr. Sierman was present and said he is seeking an abatement on his property as he was unaware of damage to the garage and home were not known when he purchased the property. He said lowering the value will allow him an opportunity to seek a neighborhood reinvestment loan. Mr. Sierman said the home was inspected prior to the sale, and the garage has been settling, pushing on the home's walls and foundation. He said he has obtained two quotes to repair the foundation and both were over \$110,000.

Mr. Kapitan asked if the garage is attached to the home. Mr. Sierman said yes, the garage and home are attached. He said the roof was replaced five years ago and the roof is pulling away from the home. He said the drywall needs to be replaced due to water and other damage from the foundation and roof issues. Mr. Peterson said his recommendation is to get drawings, bids, and a building permit for the repairs and present this information to the Commission to validate the request for the reduction. Mr. Sierman said he has a drawing and quote he can provide the Commission. Mr. Fracassi said he recommends the Commission table action on the application if they would like additional information.

#### MOTION, passed

Mrs. Scherling moved and Mr. Kapitan seconded to table action on abatement applications 4544 and 4545 to allow the applicant to provide additional information. On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

#### 8. ABATEMENT, 2022 value retained and 2023 value reduced for Strinden

Jacob Strinden has made an application for abatement on behalf of Tom and Michelle Strinden for a property located at 4773 32<sup>nd</sup> Street South in Fargo. The applicant has requested the 2022 value be lowered from \$749,400 to \$650,000, and the 2023 value be lowered from \$887,600 to \$660,000. The applicant was not present at the meeting. Mr. Fracassi said the recommendation from the City of Fargo is to reduce the 2023 value from \$887,600 to \$784,000 and to retain the value for 2022 at \$749,400.

Mr. Grindberg said he shall abstain from participating in discussions and actions of this application as the applicant is a relative.

Mrs. Scherling asked if the applicant provided evidence or sales to support their request. Mr. Fracassi said the applicant did not provide sales, however, the City of Fargo provided information to support their recommendation. He said he agrees with the sales provided by the City.

#### MOTION, passed

Mrs. Scherling moved and Mr. Breitling seconded to retain the value of \$749,000 for the 2022 tax year and reduce the value to \$784,000 for the 2023 tax year for parcel 01-8536-00610-000. On roll call vote, the motion carried with Mr. Grindberg abstaining and Mr. Peterson, Mrs. Scherling, Mr. Kapitan, and Mr. Breitling voting "yes".

#### 9. GIVING HEARTS DAY, Cass County authorized to be a Giving Hearts Day Business

County Human Resource Director/Assistant County Administrator, Tracy Peters was present and said on February 8, 2024, Dakota Medical Foundation will be hosting its annual Giving Hearts Day (GHD) event. She said GHD has been growing for over 15 years and has raised more than \$150 million for non-profit organizations. Ms. Peters said Cass County relies on non-profit organizations that provide valuable services to the community. She said the request today is to authorize Cass County to become a Giving Hearts Day Business. She said there is no financial commitment, the

County would agree to be on the list of businesses and advertise for the event such as hanging posters in county buildings.

# MOTION, passed

Mr. Kapitan moved and Mr. Breitling seconded to authorize Cass County Human Resources Director to sign Cass County up as a Giving Hearts Day Business for the February 8, 2024, Giving Hearts Day event. On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

# 10. TAX FORFEITED PROPERTIES, Parcel 01-1390-00302-020 removed from the tax sale

County Finance Director, Brandy Madrigga was present and said the request today is to remove property 01-1390-00302-020 from the annual sale of land acquired by tax deed due to extenuating circumstances. She said there is no risk to the County by removing the property from the sale, once the property is sold, the taxes will be paid in full. She said if the property is not sold, the property can be added to the sale in 2024.

### MOTION, passed

Mr. Breitling moved and Mr. Kapitan seconded to remove parcel 01-1390-00302-020 located in the City of Fargo from the annual tax sale of land acquired by tax deed, which is scheduled for Tuesday, November 21, 2023. On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

## 11. BUILDING COMMITTEE, Space needs study action tabled

County Administrator, Robert Wilson was present and said over the past several months, the Building Committee has discussed the need for additional courtroom space. He said the Committee has discussed and had a presentation from Foss Architecture on the potential to construct a new secure courtroom on the second floor of the Courthouse in the current Information Technology (IT) Office space. He said Cass County has a strong history of utilizing space needs studies when planning for future growth needs. He said in 2009, when the West Addition of the Courthouse was first considered the County engaged Foss Architecture and Kimme and Associates to produce a space needs analysis that projected county space needs out to 2020 and 2030. Mr. Wilson said in 2016, TL Stroh Architects was hired to study and make growth needs and optimal use of space recommendations in the Courthouse and the Annex Building over the next five to ten years. He said in 2021, prior to current project to add additional jail housing units, the County engaged Klein McCarthy Architects to develop a jail population forecast to projected inmate capacity needs at multiple future points in time. Mr. Wilson said Judge Steven McCullough has also provided an assessment of future needs for the courts based on historic records.

Mr. Wilson said at the last Building Committee meeting, the committee directed staff to prepare space needs study options to be considered. He said for consideration by the Commission today are space study options not limited to: option one; a limited scope to identify a suitable replacement location for IT Offices to allow for the reconstruction of the second floor space into a secure courtroom; option two which would include option one plus additional analysis of how the County acquiring the Robert D. Johnson Building from the Fargo Park District could be utilized; and option three a comprehensive analysis of current and future needs for Cass County that include the Courthouse, Annex, and Robert. D. Johnson Building. Mr. Wilson said earlier today at the Building Committee meeting, the Committee recommended the Commission approve moving forward with option one, a limited space needs study to find a suitable replacement space for IT.

Mr. Peterson said he supports option one for now as it is the immediate need. He said in the next few to several years the County will likely need a comprehensive space needs study to plan for growth. He said if a comprehensive study is completed now, the study will likely be that additional court space is needed and the County does not have 50 million to pay for a courthouse addition. Mr. Breitling said he has concerns about jumping to the conclusion that additional courtrooms are needed. Mr. Wilson said the 2009 Kimmy study identified the IT Department was lacking due to being scattered throughout the Courthouse and thus when the Courthouse Addition was competed, the current IT space was created specifically for IT to fit their specific needs. He said he is worried

moving IT from the space created for them may be counterproductive. Mr. Kapitan said he voted against the Building Committee's recommendation today. He said he is worried about displacing IT as it is an essential department. He said he understands the courts have needs and the County should look for an alternative solution.

County Information Technology Director, Bob Henderson was present and said he understands this is a difficult decision as the courts are important to the community. He said he would like to see data to support the notion that additional court space is needed. He said some parts of the IT office, such as the server room, cannot be moved and would have to stay in the current location. He said IT has specific storage and accessibility needs for office space. County State's Attorney, Kim Hegvik was present and said the State's Attorney's Office works closely with District Court. She said many people go through the court system and if the county does not look big picture, the County will be behind. She said IT is critical to the County and no department can function without them.

Mr. Grindberg asked if a timeline was discussed at the Building Committee. Mr. Peterson said the work would begin immediately. Mr. Grindberg asked what data was provided by the Courts to support the need of an additional courtroom. Mr. Wilson said Judge McCullough provided a report he is working on and no other data was provided. Mr. Peterson said one judge wants one additional courtroom and all the other judges want a new courthouse or an addition.

Mrs. Scherling said IT would be the most expensive department to move. She said more analysis into all the County's options is needed. She suggested the possibility of looking to add a secure courtroom at the Jail or having the additional courtroom in the current Commission Chambers. Mr. Peterson said the study needs to be done to see if there is a spot to move IT. He said there may be no good replacement space and then the project will not be plausible.

MOTION, passed

Mr. Grindberg moved and Mr. Kapitan seconded to table action on the space needs study. Motion carried.

#### 12. COURT FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT GRANT APPLICATION

Mr. Wilson said December 31, 2023, is the deadline for counties to submit applications for Court Facilities Grant funding through the North Dakota Supreme Court. Grant funds may be used for improvements or maintenance projects for court facilities and are available to fund up to 75% of the total project cost. Mr. Wilson said earlier today, the Building Committee recommended two projects. He said the first project is a glass window project for the Clerk's Office. He said the project would construct a secure public facing counter and window similar to the Sheriff's Office Civil and Warrants division on the first floor of the Courthouse. Mr. Wilson said if approved, cost estimates will be procured prior to submitting the application.

Mr. Wilson said the second application recommended by the Building Committee is for the grant to provide funds to purchase furniture needed for the additional courtroom discussed during the last Commission item. Mr. Peterson said he is on the Court Facilities Improvement Advisory Committee and there is no funding available, however, the County should always apply in the case an approved project does not get completed and funding becomes available.

#### MOTION, passed

Mrs. Scherling moved and Mr. Breitling seconded to authorize the Chair to sign and staff to submit a Court Facilities Improvement Grant application for 75% of the cost of the Clerk's Glass Window project. On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

13. BLUE CROSS BLUE SHIELD, <u>Commissioner Kapitan authorized to act as agent for Healthy</u>
<u>Dakota Mutual Holdings Board of Directors ballot</u>

The County received a ballot for the annual meeting of Healthy Dakota Mutual Holdings (Healthy Dakota), which is a mutual not-for-profit holding company, which owns Blue Cross Blue Shield of North Dakota (BCBSND). The ballot is to vote for their Board of Directors, who serve as members for Healthy Dakota and BCBSND. Mr. Peterson said for the past few years former Commissioner Rick Steen completed the ballot. Mr. Kapitan said he would fill out the ballot for this year.

### MOTION, passed

Mr. Kapitan moved and Mr. Peterson seconded to authorize Commissioner Kapitan to act as County agent and sign the ballot as instructed by the Cass County Commission for the Healthy Dakota Board of Directors. Motion carried.

### 14. VOUCHERS, Approved

MOTION, passed

Mr. Breitling moved and Mr. Grindberg seconded to approve Voucher No. 339747 through Voucher No. 339968 for a total of \$3,032,068,85. On roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

#### 15. MEETING UPDATES, Committee reports

Commissioners and staff reported on meetings they have attended or will be attending in the upcoming weeks.

Mr. Wilson said last week, the Fargo Park Board accepted the County's offer to purchase the Robert D. Johnson Building for \$825,000. He said he will work with the Fargo Park District's Executive Director to coordinate a purchase agreement and finalize the purchase.

Mrs. Scherling said the Flood Sales Tax Committee met today and discussed many great projects. She said she would like Ms. Madrigga to give the Commission a financial update on where the Flood Sales Tax Funds have been spent throughout the County.

Mr. Peterson said the Red River Regional Dispatch Center's (RRRDC) Executive Director will resign effective January 1, 2024, and the RRRDC Board of Directors has begun searching for a replacement.

#### 16. ADJOURNMENT

MOTION, passed

On motion by Mr. Kapitan, seconded by Mr. Grindberg and all in favor, the meeting was adjourned at 5:05 PM.

There was discussion about other board and committee assignments, including outside agency representation.

The Board discussed the regularly scheduled meetings for 2024. The Board decided to change the second meeting in July to July 16 as the National Association of Counties conference is July 12 to 15, and change the second meeting in October to October 23 as the North Dakota Association of counties conference is October 20 to 22. Mr. Peterson said he would also like to set the dates of 2024 budget hearings and add them to the calendar. The Board discussed setting budget hearings for July 24, July 25, and July 26 if needed. Mrs. Scherling said she would like to schedule dates for the Flood Sales Tax Committee meetings in April and November for an hour and a half period to allow for enough time to consider all applications and discuss project updates.

Mr. Breitling moved and Mr. Kapitan seconded to recommend the discussed portfolios, committee assignments, and meeting dates to be formally adopted at the next Commission meeting on December 4, 2023. Motion carried.
