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Dear Commissioners,

In March the County Commission approved the consulting with Eide Bailey, LLP. The consulting included staff interviews with several departments to gather requirements for a website platform.

The enclosed presentation is a result of the study and recommendations to move forward. Their recommendations include migrating from hosting the County website internally to a hosting it in the cloud on one of several government specific content management systems reviewed as part of the study.

Recommendations from the study will be incorporated in the 2016 budget request.

## Major project goals included:

1. Document and prioritize Cass County's requirements for Cass County's future web platform.
2. Evaluate the technical platform options for delivery of Cass County web services.
3. Identify organizational responsibility for management of web and social media content.
4. Identify solutions that will increase utilization of the Cass County web site.

# Requirements Summary

	Requirement	Description	Priority
1	Content Management	Create and maintain content using non-technical data entry techniques. Editing tools should support multiple headings/font styles, images, links, and text formatting. Content editors can manage content based on their permissions.	High
2	Editorial Control	Support a process to ensure spelling, grammar, mood, style, and voice consistency across content. Align messaging with organization goals. Content publishers can manage publication based on permissions and use scheduling tools.	High
3	Document Management	Documents (PDF files, images, maps) can be stored within the site and optionally made available for web visitor viewing/downloading.	High
4	Search	Web visitors can search for content and results are returned in an efficiently-reviewable manner. Type-ahead/suggested searches provide additional benefit and flexibility.	High
5	Responsive / Mobile Design	Site design should adapt to a visitor's screen size (mobile phone, tablet computer, and desktop with multiple resolutions)	High
6	Notifications	Web visitors can subscribe to site content updates. Notifications should be triggered automatically when content is published.	High

	Requirement	Description	Priority
7	Meeting Manager	Organize meeting agendas. Share reports, minutes, and newsletters.	Medium
8	Form Builder	Create basic forms allowing users to submit content via the website. Editing controls should include: textbox, paragraph text box, multi-select checkbox, and drop down list. Submitted forms should trigger a notification to the form's owner.	High
9	Employment Application	Applicants can submit an initial application online and upload a resume. Includes basic applicant management functionality.	Medium
10	Custom Integrations	Provide the ability to retrieve data from external systems and display it within the context of the site (current inmate list, warrants, etc.). Present content within the site that is hosted externally (videos, etc).	High
11	Social Network Integrations	Published content cross-posts/updates social networks (Facebook, Twitter, etc)	High
12	PDF Viewer	PDF files open within the context of the site rather than downloading or opening in a separate viewer. Once opened on the site, the file can be browsed, printed, and downloaded.	High
13	Non-emergency Request Tracker	Citizens can submit information to the county about non-emergency situations.	Medium

	Requirement	Description	Priority
14	Online Payments	Web visitors can submit online payments that route through a merchant account and notify recipient.	High
15	Media Gallery	Publish photos into attractive photo galleries	Medium
16	Licenses and Permits	Citizens can apply for licenses and permits without coming in to county offices.	High
17	Facility Reservations	Citizens can check availability and reserve public spaces.	Medium
18	Alternate / Emergency Homepage	Presents web visitors with a distinct page during a time of emergency.	Medium

- Cass County has three viable options for redesign of the county website:
  1. **Government-Specific Content Management System (CMS)** – Have the new website developed on a service and platform that is focused on meeting the needs of government clients.
  2. **Redevelop on SharePoint** – Continue with SharePoint as the platform for redevelopment of the county website, improving the layout and operations to better meet requirements.
  3. **Custom Develop** – Select industry-standard technology platform and custom build the new county website.

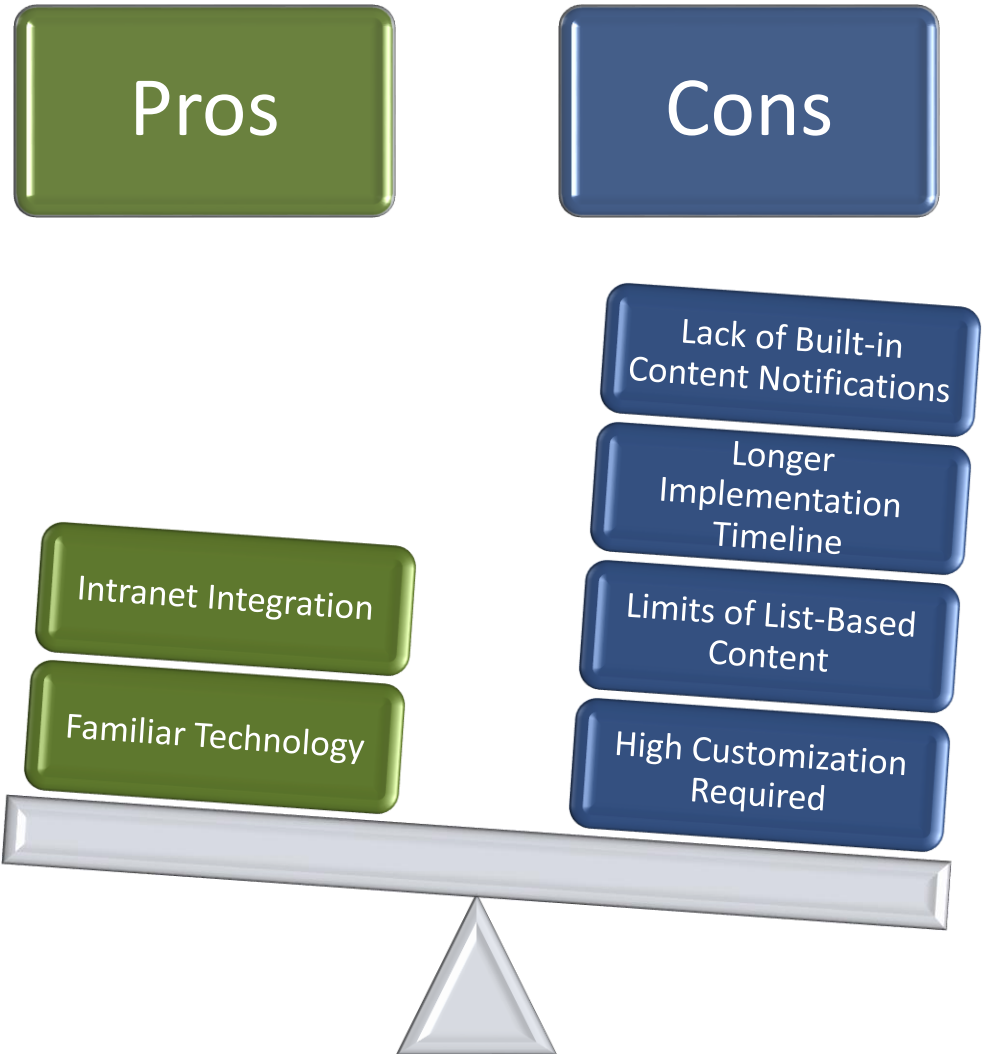

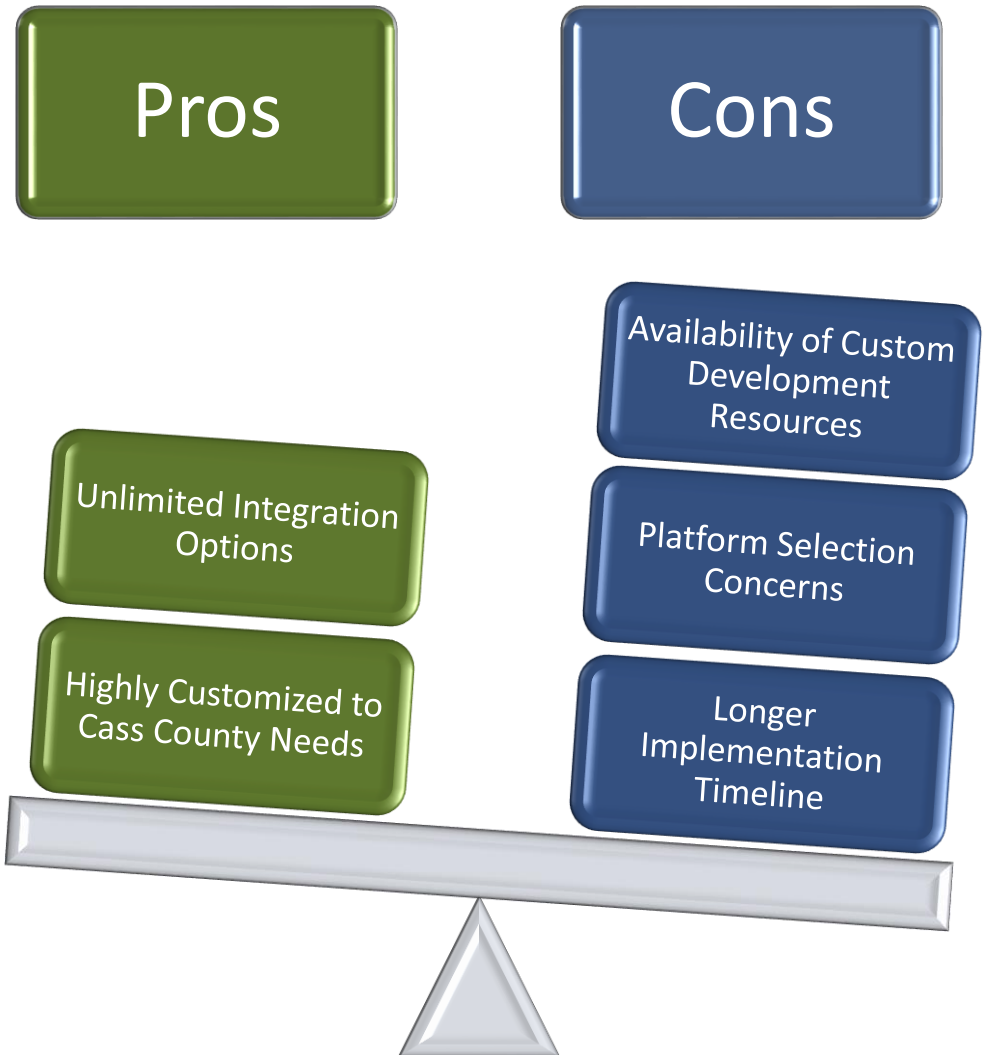

- Improved website functionality for Cass County will require changes in the following areas:
  - **People** – Assignment of communication and website operations duties.
  - **Process** – Improved editorial and content management processes.
  - **Technology** – Migration to a modern contemporary platform (Government-Specific CMS) for delivery of website content, services and social media content.



- **People** recommendations. . .

1. Establish a primary “editor” for all Cass County web and social media content (Dedicated staff TBD) .

Options for editor responsibility include:

- Establish a small (2 – 3 people) committee with existing communications and / or web content responsibilities.
- Redistribute responsibilities of existing staff and create a dedicated role.
- Hire a new FTE.

- **Process** recommendations . . .
  1. Establish a centralized editorial process for all web and social media content.
  2. Assign responsibility for proactive improvement of website content and services (For all departments).
  3. Establish standard processes and methods for constituent notifications (Replace the unique departmental solutions and GovDelivery).

- **Technology** recommendations . . .

1. Select and implement one of the leading government-specific CMS platforms (Migrate off of the existing SharePoint solution).
2. Outsource website design, development and hosting.
3. Replace GovDelivery (Integrated functionality with future website platform).
4. Recommended government-specific CMS platforms to consider in evaluation:
  - CivicPlus (1,800+ clients)
  - Vision Internet (600+ clients)
  - Revize (800+ clients)
  - Evogov (No specific client claims)

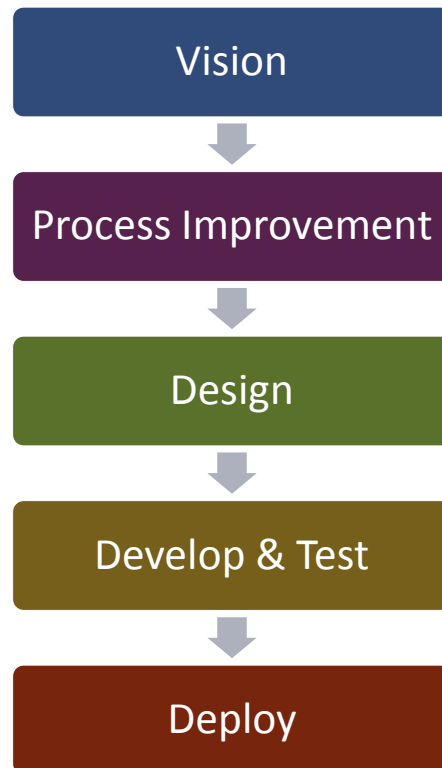
- Based on our review of other similar projects (for Counties, Cities and local government entities), we recommend Cass County budget the following:

Item	Low Estimate	High Estimate
<u>One-Time Costs</u>		
Website Design, Development & Implementation	\$50,000	\$70,000
Data Migration	\$5,000	\$10,000
<b>Total One-Time Costs:</b>	<b>\$55,000</b>	<b>\$80,000</b>
<u>Annual Costs</u>		
Hosting & System Maintenance	\$5,000	\$15,000

*Note: Final costs will be highly dependent on the level of custom integration selected by Cass County.*

- There are several considerations related to staff time and costs for development, operations and support of the current County website:
  - Web-site Development / Vendor Costs
    - \$25,607 (2013 – 2015)
  - Annual Savings Opportunities
    - GovDelivery \$8,926 (Starting in 2017)
    - SharePoint Licensing \$1,591 (Starting in 2016)
  - Indirect Costs
    - Internal Staff SharePoint and Database Administration Time (vs. a Service provided by the Government Specific Content Management System)
    - Hardware and Software Licensing Costs (For internal hosting)

1. Evaluate major government-specific CMS vendors.
2. Website Development Process
