CASS COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION October 26, 2023

A. CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Cass County Planning Commission was called to order on October 26, 2023 at 7:00 am in the West Fargo Public Works conference room.

B. ROLL CALL

Planning Commissioners attending in person were Rocky Bertsch, David Gust, Ken Lougheed, Dr. Tim Mahoney, Keith Monson, Brad Olson, Commissioner Duane Breitling and Hugh Veit. Keith Gohdes was absent.

Attending in person were Cole Hansen, Cass County Planner, Jason Benson, Cass County Engineer, Tom Soucy, Assistant Cass County Engineer. Katherine Naumann, Senior Attorney attended via Teams.

C. DETERMINATION OF A QUORUM

It was determined that there was a quorum based on the roll call.

D. MINUTES, APPROVED

MOTION, passed

Mr. Gust moved and Mr. Olson seconded to approve the minutes of the September 28, 2023 meeting as presented.

Motion carried.

E. PUBLIC HEARING

1. Hearing on an application requesting a Minor Subdivision Plat of Lehman Subdivision located in Section 14, Township 141 North, Range 51 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Rush River Township, Cass County, North Dakota.

Mr. Lougheed opened the public hearing.

The applicant is seeking approval of a minor subdivision entitled Lehman Subdivision to plat a one (1) Lot subdivision of approximately 3.5 acres. According to the applicant, the subdivision is requested to sell the existing farmstead and separate it from the balance of the parcel.

The proposed ownership and maintenance responsibility of the subdivision will be private. The subdivision will use an existing 27th St SE road access, ditches for storm sewer conveyance, rural water. The property currently does have an on-site septic system for wastewater treatment.

Upon hearing no public comment, the public hearing was closed.

Mr. Lougheed opened the public hearing.

The applicant is seeking approval of a minor subdivision entitled Pfaff Subdivision to plat a one (1) Lot subdivision of approximately 2 acres. According to the applicant, the subdivision is requested to build a new residential building and/or shop.

The proposed ownership and maintenance responsibility of the subdivision will be private. The subdivision will use 44th St SE for road access, ditches for storm sewer conveyance, rural water. The property currently does not have an on-site septic system for wastewater treatment.

Upon hearing no public comment, the public hearing was closed.

3. Hearing on an application requesting a Minor Subdivision Plat of Arthur Punton Subdivision located in Section 22, Township 141 North, Range 54 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, Ayr Township, Cass County, North Dakota.

Mr. Lougheed opened the public hearing.

The applicant is seeking approval of a minor subdivision entitled Arthur Punton Subdivision to plat a one (1) Lot subdivision of approximately 2 acres. According to the applicant, the subdivision is requested to construct a residential building.

The proposed ownership and maintenance responsibility of the subdivision will be private. The subdivision will use an existing County Road 3 road access, ditches for storm sewer conveyance, rural water. The property currently does not have an on-site septic system for wastewater treatment.

Mr. Olson asked about access to the property. The current access is at the ¼ line. The applicants will have to upgrade the access and only have one access; they cannot keep both accesses. Mr. Veit asked what happens if the applicants refuse to update the access or want both accesses. Mr. Benson said the county has a policy in place where the county has the authority to remove the access. Mr. Benson also went on to explain that the right of way of the access can be widened. The county would not allow much more than 30' wide; it is allowed to add additional length for a culvert. Depending on the age of the culvert, the county would pay for the replacement of the existing culvert, the owner would pay for any additional length that may be required.

Mr. Soucy said that this area also has good water drainage and the field where the new residential home will be built is on a high spot of the property.

Upon hearing no further public comments, the public hearing was closed.

MOTION, passed

Mr. Gust moved, Commissioner Breitling seconded to accept the findings and recommendations of staff and recommend approval to the County Commission of the subdivision application, including updating the access to only one, as the proposal meets the goals and objectives of the Cass County Comprehensive Plan, the Cass County Highway Access Plan, the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, the Cass County Subdivision Ordinance and all other applicable regulations.

F. NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Hansen noted that the December 14, 2023 meeting will have approximately seven applications to go through. He would like to only send a hard copy to the Planning Commissioners as emailing could be difficult due to the size of the documents. Planning Commissioners indicated only a hard copy is acceptable.

Mr. Benson also gave an update that he and Mr. Hansen have been attending Fargo Growth Plan meetings. These meetings are to prepare areas such as Harwood and Reiles Acres for future growth,

There was no old business to discuss.







Section 6, Lake Township Township 142 North - Range 55 West




